During June the police attended 124 incident logs, 15 of which were anti social behaviour reports. It's early to start comparing this year's figures with last year, but so far this financial year we have recorded 22 fewer crimes in Looe than last year (86 compared to 108) a reduction of 20.4%.

The assaults this month were primarily domestic abuse offences, criminal damage has been mostly damage to parked cars, but not in any particular area and the thefts were thefts by finding, so mobile phones or other tech left unattended, a couple of thefts from boats, number plates from one car and a tractor taken from land near Lostwithiel.

Personally, I am in hospital on 4th July for the first of two necessary knee operations (the result of a misspent youth) so will be out of action for a little while.

On a good news front, the Liskeard and Looe Neighbourhood Team have been recognised for their good work and been awarded the East Cornwall Neighbourhood Team of the Year! We are delighted to have been given this award and have a ceremony to attend on 14th July.
