### **Amenities Report**

#### **Repairs to wall of Mariner's Garden**

The wall repair work is finally due to commence on Tues 5<sup>th</sup> September after several weeks of issues with the scaffolding company. The MMO have been informed and progress will be monitored by us and the contractors' Project Manager, Steve Walsh. Work is expected to be completed within 13 weeks.

#### **Graffiti**

Following several instances of graffiti around the town, the Town Council, local businesses, Cornwall Council and the Police have joined forces with the Looe Pioneers running group to co-ordinate identification and clean up of graffiti.

Looe Pioneers have volunteered to clean offending areas once permission has been obtained from property owners. We are coordinating all reports from members of the public and liaising with property owners, Cornwall Council and utilities companies.

Members of the public are encouraged to report any graffiti to the Council via the online 'contact us' enquiry form and not through social media.

### **TIC Report**

The Tourist Information Centre are selling Looe Music Festival tickets on a 10% commission basis. T-shirts will be on sale from Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> September on the same terms as the ticket sales.

The Tourist Information Centre will be open on Sundays up to, and including, the festival weekend to assist with ticket and merchandise sales. Opening hours will be 12pm – 5pm and staffed by our own staff at a cost of around £160 in total.
