1. During October three of our Year 9 e-safety ambassadors went to the Houses of Parliament to present an e-safety activity to students from London schools. The students delivered and discussed an activity based upon social media and used emojis to rank the feelings of the other students. Our students also discussed the merits of the units of study with the CEO from the Diana Award who arranged the event and had detailed conversations about the benefits to representatives from Vodafone who sponsored the event. We were also very pleased to receive a visit from our own MP for South East Cornwall Sheryll Murray who was working at Westminster at the time.
2. Our school show jumping team won the Cornish Schools Show Jumping Competition on the 13th November which was held at the Pendarves Equestrian Centre.

The Bar Mock Trial competition is a national competition aimed at sixth form law students; it immerses students in all aspects of a criminal trial, as they take on the roles of barristers, witnesses, clerks, ushers and jury members.
6. Some of our students took part in a workshop at the Looe Literary Festival last weekend which was a fantastic opportunity to be involved in a community event and inspire younger writers.
