Amenities Report

The Seafront public conveniences are now closed until Christmas week which will allow the cleaning staff to undertake much needed redecoration and deep cleaning on these facilities followed by an extensive programme of works scheduled for all of the other public conveniences between November and February 2018.

Cllr Rose and I are currently undertaking a review of Risk Assessments on the cleaning and care and public use of the public conveniences.

Our public convenience operatives will shortly be receiving formal training from Cormac on cleaning processes, chemical competency, sharps and clinical waste and manual handling. This will provide both the Council and staff with reassurance that they have received appropriate and adequate training.

We will be having an audit of our Legionella Risk Assessment and Controls later this month to ensure that our risk remains minimal.

We are looking at an Asbestos Management Survey and in the process of obtaining quotes for this. These should be available for the next meeting.
