

Amenities Report to Tourism & Amenities Committee – 23rd May 2018

Mariner's Garden

The repair work on the river wall of Mariner's Garden has almost been completed and the contractor is in the process of making good in order that the beds can be replanted and the garden reopened. We will need to replace a tree removed when the garden was previously refurbished in 2014/5.

Seagull Control

We have had 82 properties register for seagull control this year, compared to 63 properties last year. Ray and his team from Kernow Aerials have now almost completed the replacement of live eggs for dummy eggs as per the licence granted by Natural England.

Weed control

Our contractor has now completed the first of two weed sprays this year around the town (approx. 20km of paths); the second spray is scheduled for early autumn.

Graffiti

We continue to suffer with bouts of random graffiti around the town and, despite best efforts, the perpetrator is yet to be apprehended. The Police have been given names of individuals possibly involved and they continue their investigations. In the meanwhile, we in conjunction with CC, continue to clean up instances of graffiti as they occur.
