

### **Barbican Road, Looe, Surfacing**

Resurfacing work will commence on Barbican Road in Looe starting Monday 3 September, between 9.30am and approximately 3pm each day. The work is expected to complete in three weeks with the road being clear before Looe Music Festival commences.

The shorter working days have been planned to minimise disruption as much as possible, especially for nearby schools.

The work will be split into three phases under a combination of closure & traffic lights.

Phase One will see work on the southern section of the site, starting below the junction with Pendennis Road. The work in this phase will be split into two parts so that access to the east Plaidy area can be maintained via Hay Lane initially, and then Meadway or Bay View Road via Bodrigan Road.

Phase Two will cover the section of road from the junction of Pendennis Road to just below the junction with Bodrigan Road. Access to the south will be maintained via Bodrigan Road.

Phase Three will see work on the remainder of the road, from the junction with Bodrigan Road all the way up to the B3253. This will be kept open under traffic lights for the majority of this phase; but a closure for a maximum of two days will be required for the work around the traffic island, during which time there will be insufficient width to accommodate through traffic. There will be additional signing placed on site to advise road users of the exact dates of these closures.

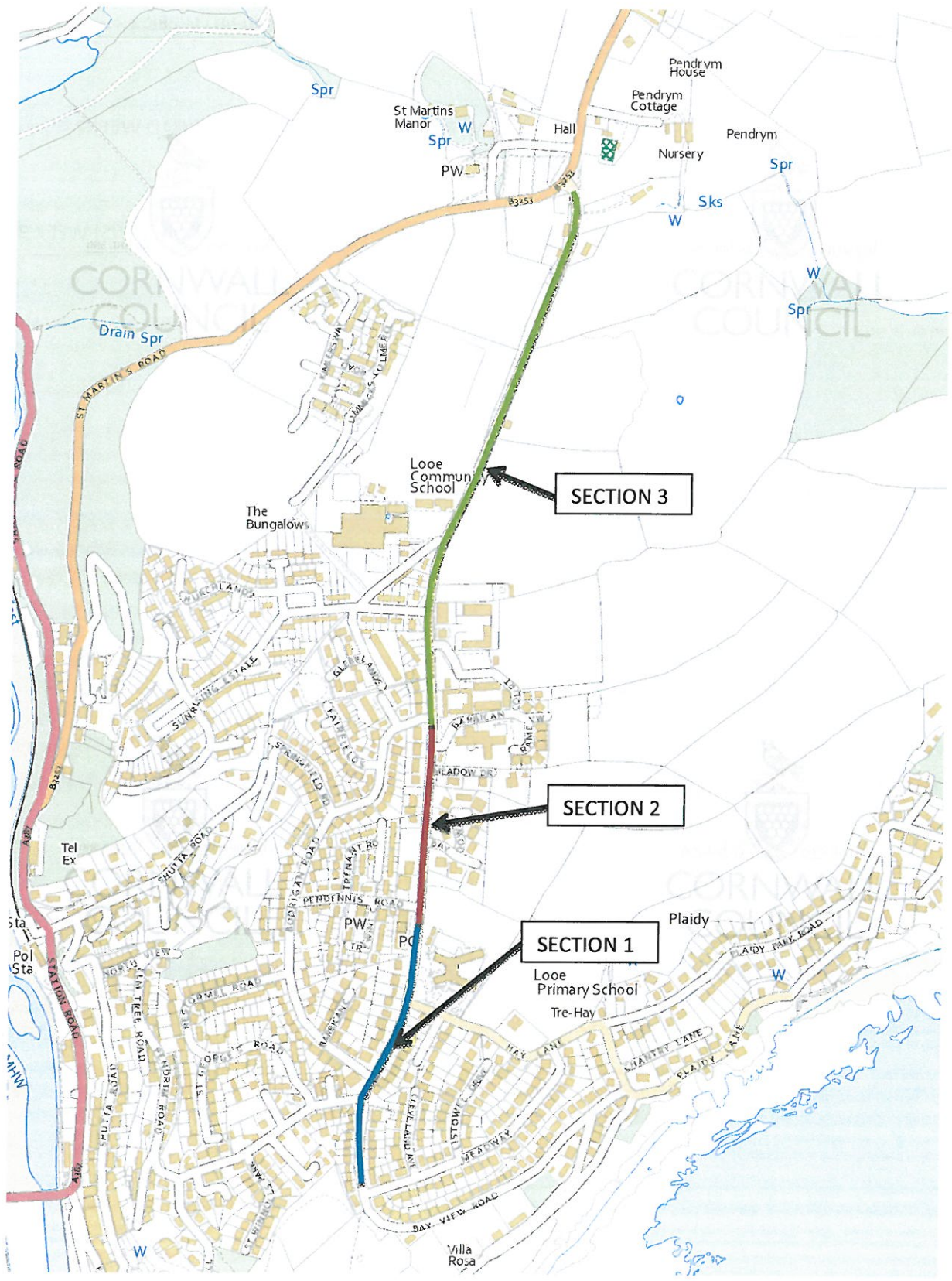
Emergency vehicles will be given access at all times.
