

ST MARTINS ROAD CLOSURE – 16th February 2019 – 13th April 2019

UPDATE ONE – 28th January 2019

Dear All, I am passing on this information on the closure of St Martins Road and will continue these updates through the closure.

1. Cornwall Council is setting up an individual web page for the closure as they did last time. This will contain information on the works. It will also contain all the questions asked and answers given to residents and those wanting to know.
2. They are also producing a map for residents and businesses to use so that people coming to the town will have the correct directions to avoid delays.
3. The works will be done with three teams working from the top, middle and bottom. This will hopefully speed the works up, a weekly progress report will be given.
4. There will be traffic lights on Barbican Hill plus marshalls during key times such as the school run. This will hopefully stop delays and help flows of traffic, the team are working on how to address the issue with residents access to properties.
5. Parking has been agreed for the school run and discussion on parking tickets are being worked on with local schools.
6. Plymouth City bus have had discussions with Cornwall Council and have a draft timetable in place for a revised service for Sunrising Barbican etc.
7. Extra Signage for Hessenford area, Sandplace Road (pedestrian safety), Trerulefoot and other areas leading to Looe have been asked for.

This is the first update of many and will keep you informed of events as they happen.
