12. TO RECEIVE DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

13. TO DISCUSS NEW YEAR'S EVE 2007  
The Clerk reported that the road closure has been applied for and Dave Peat Waste have been contacted regarding the refuse collection. Sgt Bassett reported that he will try and book the CCTV van for the evening, recent trials at Hannafore proved to be very good. The Clerk was asked to approach Councillor Rothwell to ask if his sons would again act as stewards for the firework display and to write to East Looe Town Trust to ask if they will provide barriers for both entrances to the beach. The Chairman will chase up the possible donation from Caradon District Council car parks as verbally suggested by Mr. Masters at Caradon District Council.

14. TO DISCUSS THE TORCHLIGHT PROCESSION  
The Chairman reported that the lantern making workshop on the 6<sup>th</sup> October had gone very well, much larger lanterns are being made this year which will be carried by adults, the children carrying smaller ones and the workshop was well attended. Sgt Bassett requested that a road closure for Shutta Hill be applied for between 6.00pm and 7.00pm for the assembly of the group at the Globe Inn, policing from then on will be provided as usual. As the Carol Service will be held in the Rose Garden concerns were raised

over people congregating on Fore Street, it was agreed that the marshals will “police” this if it becomes an obstruction of the road. It was also agreed that there should be three marshals for each procession headed by two members of a band (yet to be ascertained).
