- 219. APOLOGIES** Apologies for absence were received from Councillors Mrs. E. Hannford, M. Joy, R. J. Overd C. Rose, W. Scarah and J. Rothwell.

- .1 Personal Interests  
Councillors Gregory and Toms declared an interest in applicant Mrs. Katrina Ring as Looe Junior School Governors.

- 221. TO INTERVIEW CANDIDATES FOR CO-OPTION TO LOOE TOWN COUNCIL**  
As each candidate was interviewed the Chairman explained that he was Chairing the meeting due to the Mayor's on-going ill health.
