23. TO RECEIVE DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

Councillors Bryan and Galipeau declared an interest in any matter raised concerning East Looe Town Trust.

24. TO DISCUSS THE LANTERN PROCESSION

The Chairman informed the Committee that the “battery workshop” to put batteries in the lanterns will be on Saturday 12th December at 10am and asked for volunteers.

The general arrangements for the procession were discussed and it was agreed that the stewards for each procession and various other locations be as per attached appendix.

Mr Penhaligan will arrange for radios to be available for co-ordination and for lights to be put up on the fish market. He will also provide access along the quay for the procession and the sound system vehicle and arrange for the area to be cleared of vehicles.

It was agreed that giving prizes for best lanterns is very difficult and possibly controversial so it was decided that Certificates of Commendation be given to everyone who has made a lantern instead.

The Clerk informed the Committee that the pipers that had been organised have let us down and will not be attending.

The Clerk was asked to try to source other musical availability for the procession.
