81. TO RECEIVE DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

Councillors Bryan, Rose and Smith declared an interest in any matter raised concerning East Looe Town Trust.

82. TO DISCUSS THE LITTER HITTER CAMPAIGN 2009

The Committee discussed this at length as the areas we normally cover are being done by the Mums of Looe on the 18th April.

It was eventually agreed that Looe Town Council should collect the litter from the Community School along Barbican Road, the Shutta area and the Millpool area.

The Clerk was asked to ask Looe Divers if they would be willing to dive into the Millpool again to clear the litter and to enlist assistance from the Army Cadets, Brownies etc.

The date agreed is Saturday 4th April at 9.00am at the Community School or designated area.

83. TO DISCUSS TRAFFIC ISSUES

Various issues were discussed as follows:

.1 Barbican Hill (Pendrim Road junction – vehicles parked illegally, P.C. Libby will monitor this.

.2 Hannafore Road (just past the Church) – vehicles parked illegally – the police cannot enforce, this is a matter for the Civil Enforcement Officers. The Clerk was asked to ask for patrols in the area.

.3 Globe Inn – illegal parking on the pavement. P.C. Libby will speak to the landlord.

.4 The Clerk was asked to contact Councillor Toms regarding the progress of the following issues.

a) Double yellow lines on Church Street/Princes Square, West Looe.

b) The signage at Bridgend, East Looe

c) Parking restrictions on Sandplace Road

d) To ask for the presence of Civil Enforcement Officers on Sundays and evenings and for patrols of Hannafore Road, West Looe.

The Committee felt this to be too hazardous as Bridgend is very busy.

PC Libby suggested the “keep clear” area outside the Riverside as an alternative, the Committee agreed with the suggestion and the Clerk was asked to respond.
