### NOTES OF THE MEETINGS REGARDING REFUSE COLLECTIONS IN LOOE

The first meeting had been held on Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> April 2010 in order to resolve the issue of litter on the streets due to the lack of litter bins being provided. As Looe Harbour Commission had rejected an offer made by Looe Town Council, who manage the street cleaning, which required Looe Harbour Commission to put their litter bins back in place, empty them first thing every morning with Cornwall Council staff to empty them for the rest of the day, negotiations were commenced to try to resolve this issue.

East Looe Town Trust stated that, due to the lack of Looe Harbour Commission litter bins more rubbish is being put into their bins on the seafront increasing the workload for East Looe Town Trust staff.

After much discussion it was agreed that the best way forward was to map the current locations of Cornwall Council and East Looe Town Trust litter bins and re-convene on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> April.

Mr David, Mr Hutchins (both Cornwall Council) and Mr Cotton gave their apologies for this meeting.

Mr Lee produced a map of the location of Cornwall Council litter bins around the centre of Looe (ten in total) and agreed to re-locate two other lesser used bins, one to the Guildhall (by the Looe Town Council notice board) and one to outside Barclays Bank.

Looe Harbour Commission – Ms Hicks stated that she would ask the permission of the Commissioners to put ten bins out provided that Cornwall Council would agree to empty them and provide black bin bags, this was agreed by Mr Lee.

East Looe Town Trust – In order to alleviate the current problems Cornwall Council have agreed to empty the ten bins between the Beach Cafe and the Public Conveniences building on the seafront providing East Looe Town Trust empty them first thing in the morning.

Some of this is subject to Looe Harbour Commission's agreement to the proposal and, will be reviewed at the next meeting on 1<sup>st</sup> June 2010 at 2pm.
