5. **APOLOGIES**

6. **TO DISCUSS THE FUTURE PLANS FOR THE CCTV SYSTEM**

The Chairman asked Councillor Welch for an update on the system. Cllr Welch reported that a company called 'Systemtech' had been and rectified the problems that we had and have streamlined the equipment in the office. They also reported that the existing cameras need to be upgraded as the ones we have are more for internal purposes and do not provide the clarity of image required by the Police.

The Chairman stated that we have to decide whether to upgrade the current system or completely replace it.

Quotations have been received which were discussed but it was agreed that we need to provide an exact brief of requirement and then request quotations again as, at the moment, it is difficult to make comparisons.

It was also agreed that the Police should be asked to provide a list of 'hotspots' for the positioning of the cameras.

The Chairman agreed to provide the brief, to be agreed with Councillor Joy. It was requested by Councillor Galipeau that the content of the brief be approved by Full Council. In the meantime we will continue to run the current system.

When the new quotes have been received Councillors will visit the Companies for a demonstration.
