TO DISCUSS TENDERS FOR THE SEASONAL EVENING BUS SERVICE

Mr Nicholson informed all present that three bids had been received as follows: (see also attached Appendix).

- .1 First - £2402 per week
variation to timetable reduced this to £1,322 per week
- .2 ERH Roadcar - £890 per week
- .3 Western Greyhound – 24/5 – 25/7 - £395 per week
26/7 – 29/8 - £0
30/8 – 20/9 - £425 per week
21/9 – 31/10 - £455 per week

Total cost for period 24/5 – 31/10 = £7530

As Western Greyhound are stating that they cannot pick up at Carey Park, Mr Joliff stated that he needs to take the proposal back to his Council for approval.

It was agreed that, subject to approval of Lansallos Parish Council, the tender from Western Greyhound be accepted.

The previously agreed donations would now be:

Cornwall Council: £3765
Looe Town Council: £3012
Lansallos PC: £753

As these donations will be less than the original agreement it was proposed and unanimously agreed that some of the residue be used for marketing purposes, split proportionately as follows:

Cornwall Council - £500

Looe Town Council and Lansallos Parish Council - £250 each

This will result in the total donations being:

Cornwall Council - £4265

Looe Town Council - £3262

Lansallos Parish Council - £1003

A meeting with Western Greyhound will be arranged at the end of the period.

A questionnaire will be formulated by Mr Joliff and, when agreed, will be handed out on the buses and monitored by Cornwall Council, a similar questionnaire will be put into the businesses in Looe and Polperro to ascertain the usage of the service.
