9. APOLOGIES

Apologies for absence were received from Councillors Mrs B King and
Ms A Milner (Former Traffic Warden).

10. TO RECEIVE DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

Councillor Bryan declared an interest in any matter raised concerning East
Looe Town Trust.

**11. TO DISCUSS FURTHER THE RESULTS OF THE TRAFFIC
CONSULTATION DAY**

For the benefit of the Chairman Councillor Mrs Hannaford updated the
Committee on the progress so far.
Further discussions took place on the suggestions made at the previous
meeting and various amendments were made for both East and West Looe.
The recommendations so far are attached.

Mr Penhaligon informed the Committee that Looe Harbour Commission are
proposing to re-instate the roundabout at the bridge end of their car park on
Buller Quay and showed the Committee the proposed plans.
There will be provision made for 3 or 4 disabled parking spaces. The car
park will then be operated by a barrier system.
All the Committee offered their full support to this proposal if Looe Harbour
Commission decide to proceed.

It was agreed that Hannaford and Polperro Road be discussed at the next
meeting and that our proposals are then put back to the town for
consultation.

The Meeting closed at 9pm.

PROPOSALS FOR TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER SO FAR

WEST LOOE

Quay Road

1. A 3-space loading bay opposite the Harbour Moon from Bridgend.
2. No parking at all from end of loading bay to the Social Club.
3. Disabled parking from Social Club to Slipway.
4. The road to be hatched on both sides where no parking.

Princes Square/Fore Street/Church Street

1. A ½ hour, no return within 4 hour restriction between the hours of 8am and 6pm for:
 - a) 5 spaces opposite the Jolly Sailor
 - b) 3 spaces between the Jolly Sailor and the Florist.
2. The five spaces originally outside the Fire Station to be re-instated.
3. Loading bay to be made to the rear of the Florist – ie Church Street side and West Looe Hill end of Chapel Ground.
4. Extra bollards to be installed on the pavement by the Londis in between the existing ones to prevent parking.

North Road/West Road

- a) No parking at all on one side only from Bass Hill to the Downs
- b) Remove the summer restriction
- c) Site visit Goonwartha Road/ Tregarrick Junction

Polvellan Terrace

1. Two ½ hour, no return within 4 hours, spaces.

West Looe Hill

1. An “Access Only” sign at Portloe end of the road.
2. Put up a village type sign at Portloe end of the road.
3. Unsuitable for HGV sign at Portloe end of the road.
4. Better signage for pedestrians.

West Looe Bridgend Slope

1. Remove pavement and widen the road.
2. Ask West Looe Town Trust if they would consider building a cantilevered walkway from the bridge.

EAST LOOE

Fore Street

1. A Pedestrian Zone sign – Councillor Toms to investigate.
2. Loading Bays outside Chris Sandy's and Barclays Bank.
3. Disabled parking bay outside Chris Sandy's (removal of flower bed nearest to town).
4. No parking at all on either side of Fore Street.

Market Square

1. Dedicated "carers" parking space – Clerk to write to East Looe Town Trust.

Barbican Hill

1. Sign at the top of Barbican Hill stating “No Through Road”.

Tower Hill

1. Removable bollard at the top of the hill.

Barbican Road

1. Hatching on the corner of Sunrising and Barbican Road.
2. Yellow lines on Bayview Road opposite Meadway.
3. “No through Road” village type sign – Councillor Toms to investigate.
