Councillor Galipeau and Mr Penhaligon (Looe Harbour Commission) presented a draft case for a feasibility study by Plymouth University students for a low-water landing stage.

All submissions were discussed at length. All present were asked to use the form supplied by Councillor Mrs Hannaford to allocate points for each submission, the results of which are attached.

It was agreed that the next stage would be to collate all the information on the forms to identify the most viable and potentially beneficial projects. A meeting will then be arranged between the Chairman, Councillors Toms and Mrs Hannaford and the Clerk to make the final decision as to which Expressions of Interest are submitted.
