

NOTES OF THE CO-OPTION INTERVIEW MEETING

Cllr Smith informed those present that even though there was only one candidate application to consider the Council is not obliged to co-opt if the candidate is not considered suitable.

Mr Chris Rose, the only applicant, was interviewed and Cllr Bryan asked if he had resolved the issues that caused him to resign as a Councillor previously, Mr Rose responded that, due to his circumstances at that time he considered that he had over-reacted to a situation and would now treat it differently.

On being asked why he wanted to rejoin the Council Mr Rose replied that he feels that he has a lot more to offer and the Council needs more pro-active Councillors.

In response to Cllr Gregory's question Mr Rose stated that he will be standing for re-election in 2013 and had always intended to do so.

Cllr Smith asked if Mr Rose was up to date with what the Council has been doing since he resigned, Mr Rose responded that he had kept up to date through the website.

On being asked for his comments Mr Rose stated that he would like to think that no induction period would be required but would not like to join any Committees for three months to enable him to attend all Committee meetings and bring himself totally up to date before making any decision as to which Committee he would like to join.

Mr Rose then left after being thanked for his attendance.

Cllr Bryan proposed that Mr Rose be co-opted to serve as a Looe Town Councillor, seconded by Cllr Gregory it was unanimously agreed.

The Clerk was asked to inform Mr Rose by telephone as soon as possible.

The meeting closed at 4.25pm
