**205. TO DISCUSS AND APPROVE THE PLANS FOR CONVERSION OF GUILDHALL AND WEST LOOE GENTS**

The plans submitted by Cornwall Council of their proposals for conversion of the Guildhall and West Looe gents facilities to unisex, which had been circulated, were discussed at length. It was agreed that the baby changing facility in both locations was not suitable and should be incorporated into the disabled facility which should be made larger to accommodate this.

A few other minor changes were also recommended.

These requests will be taken to the meeting with Cornwall Council Officers on 21<sup>st</sup> March.

**206. TO DISCUSS A PRESS RELEASE REF MARINERS GARDEN**

A draft press release was read out by the Chairman.
