Remembrance Sunday arrangements

This year marks 100 years since the end of WW1 and as such is being marked nationally with an evening ceremony organised by the Queen's Pageant Master. In addition to the usual morning ceremony organised in conjunction with Looe British Legion, there will be an evening event taking place in the RNLI Lifeboat Station involving the Polperro Fishermen's Choir and St Pinnock's Band which will culminate in the lighting of a Beacon on Little Pier at 7pm. Arrangements for both the morning and evening events are still being finalised but we expect larger than usual spectators and participants and so road closures for Fore Street and the Bridge (to be undertaken by the Police) have been requested for the morning ceremony.

We would appreciate it if as many Councillors as possible could be in attendance for both these nationally significant ceremonies.
