



Library and Community Committee Key Message – July 2019

- Work is progressing well with the conversion of a trailer into an innovative new provision of a mobile pop up Visitor Information Centre to be positioned at key points in the town and to promote Looe outside the town.
- Conversion of Looe Library to a Community Hub to accommodate Looe Town Council offices, Information services, Visitor Information and Library has commenced a week early. We plan to reopen the Looe Community Hub in mid October with an open day.
- Council staff have been promoting the Library Summer Reading Challenge by visiting local schools, access to books for young people is available from the Millpool Centre 11am – 1pm on Tuesday and Thursdays as well as access to public computers. The click and collect service is also available and of course people can use the Borrow Box service to download e-books and audio books.
- Members supported the provision of a water refill station outside the Community Hub building following the good work of East Looe Town Trust. Members referred this issue to the Environment group to look at a wider provision across the town.
