Your Town Council has been working hard to ensure that no-one feels alone, or is suffering or isolated during this difficult time. In the next few days, a new information leaflet will be delivered by our incredible volunteers in the postal service to every household within a 3mile radius of Looe containing key information and helpful contact numbers.

Thanks to our volunteer communication team – Kimberly Spowage, Alice Lundy and Viv Sullivan we now have dedicated Facebook pages for updates where we will be posting all the latest advice for individuals and business.

I would also like to thank the officers and team at Looe Town Council for their dedication and support. As key workers themselves they are ensuring that services to the Town are maintained.

Now on our website is a list of shops and takeaways who are delivering to homes which is updated daily.
