### **Barbican Bus Shelter**

Barbican Bus Shelter is now fully operational and being serviced by Citybus as part of the normal service.

### **Barratts site Post Box**

After 3 years of campaigning with letters to both Head of Royal Mail and Highways by Armand, we have recently seen the installation of a post box for the Barratts estate. It is situated at the junction of Chough Close and Kimlers Way opposite the Council noticeboard.

### **Public Conveniences**

All public conveniences are now open for February Half Term. Seafront will be closed again from 25<sup>th</sup> February until the Easter break as is normal practice in order to complete essential maintenance works.

### **Salt Bins**

Following the wintery weather recently, all of the salt bins have been checked with a few requiring a top up. This has been flagged to Cormac to request refills.

### **Risk Assessments for Public Conveniences, Health Centre Patient's Car Park and Mariners Garden**

Cllr Rose and I are currently undertaking revision of the Risk Assessments for Council amenities. This should be completed by the end of February.

### **Amenities Manager Mobile Phone Contract**

The current mobile phone contract expires on 23 June 2019 and the notice to cancel will be submitted to EE one month beforehand whereby a PUK code will be requested. Any assistance from Councillors to find a more cost-effective SIM only deal would be greatly appreciated.
