Agenda Item 102 2a Draft Community Grants Policy

Date: 20.3.2024

**Purpose.** To consider the recommendation of the Finance and Strategy Committee to adopt the draft Community Grants Policy and application form.

**Decision Required.** Councillors are asked to adopt the policy and give delegated authority to the Finance and Strategy Committee to approve grants up to the value of £3,000.

## 3 Background

- 3.1 At the Finance and Strategy Committee Councillors agreed changes to the grants policy including changing the name of the policy from 'Donations Policy' to 'Community Grants Policy'.
- 3.2 A list of organisations who have received grants from the Council is provided as document 102d.

## 4. Policy Amendments

- 4.1 The changes to the policy and the application form are highlighted in blue. The main changes are:
  - Asking applicants to explain how their project supports the Town Council's vision for the Town
  - That Council is looking to provide grants of no more than £3,000
  - That there is the option for Council to gift items to organisations so that the VAT can be reclaimed
  - That conditions are placed on successful applicants
  - That applicants must provide information about their governance and finances
  - That applicants must seek the best price for any single item that exceeds £1,000.

## 5. Recommendation

- 5.1 That Full Council resolve to adopt the Community Grants Policy and application Form.
- 5.2 That Full Council amend the Finance and Strategy's Committee's Terms of Reference giving delegated authority to approve grant applications up to the value of £3,000.
