

Highways improvement scheme • January 2024

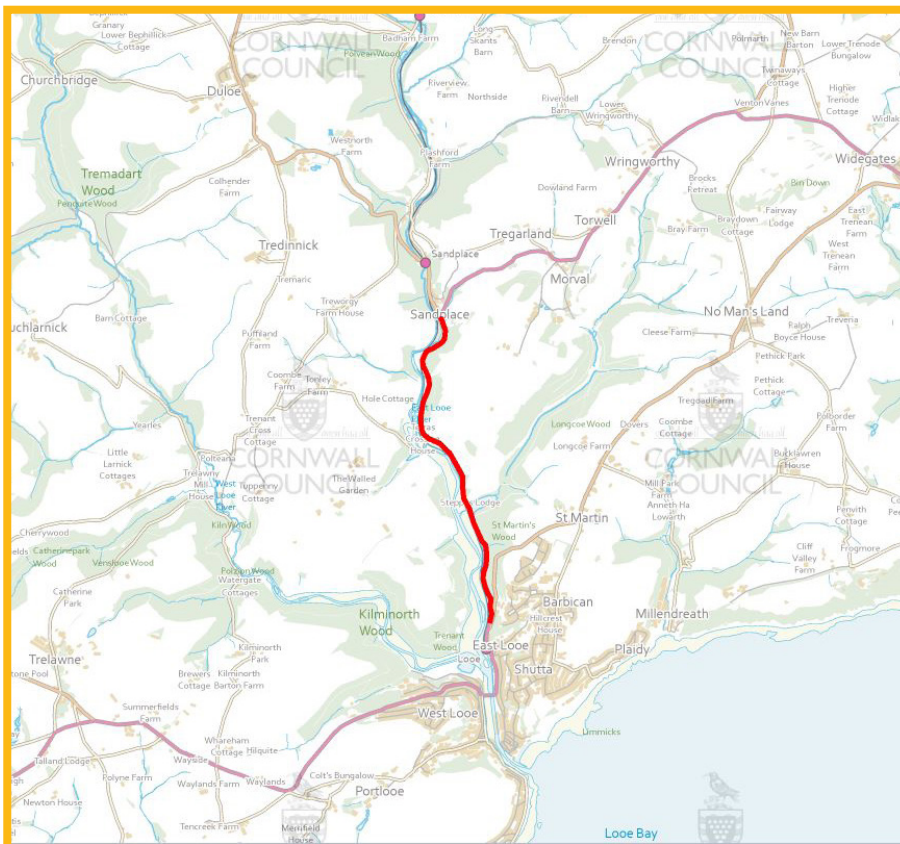
Sandplace Road, Looe

As part of our planned improvement works, a road closure will be in place on Sandplace Road in Looe from Tuesday 30 January to Friday 29 March.

Works will be carried out during the day between 7.30 am and 5.30 pm, Monday to Friday. The road closure will remain in place outside of these hours. All through traffic will need to follow the diversions in place at all times.

The narrow width of the site means we do not have sufficient space for vehicles to pass the machinery being used. These traffic management arrangements are necessary to protect road users and give our workforce a safe working zone. It also enables us to reduce the overall construction time and mitigate the need for repeated work in this location.

Please be assured our teams will make every effort to minimise disruption and complete the scheme as quickly as possible. We have programmed the works outside of the peak holiday season to minimise disruption to the local community.

Why are we doing this work?

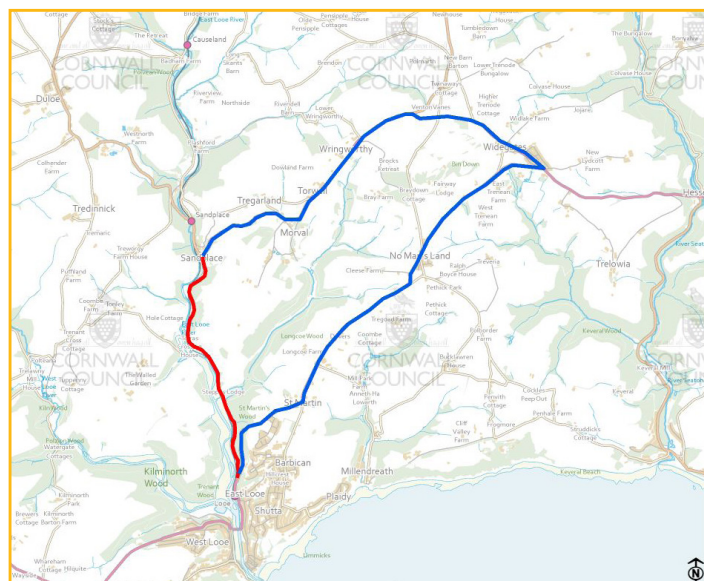
We are doing this work to increase the durability of the carriageway and deliver improvements to the existing drainage system. As well as improve pedestrian safety in this location.

What works are taking place?

The works will involve raising the existing granite kerbs between the parking bays and installing fencing. We will also carry out highway drainage work to re-establish the current drainage points to manage water flows from the carriageway.

Diversions

Signs will be placed at major junctions on the key routes prior to the road closure to minimise traffic disruption.

Diversion routes must be suitable for the type of traffic that would typically use the route. We appreciate they can sometimes be quite lengthy, but they are necessary for safety reasons.

Access arrangements

Access for residents will be maintained as normal.

The bus companies will be aware of the road closure and will be making alternative arrangements where necessary.

Emergency access will be maintained at all times.

Working safely

We encourage drivers to keep to the speed limits and follow the appropriate signage to ensure the safety of those working on site and fellow road users.

Notifications

Our work is often weather dependent and can be delayed by heavy rain.

If this situation arises, we will do our best to update the advance notice boards on the site.
