And take us to heaven to live with Thee there.

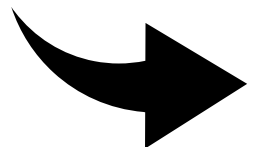


## O Little Town of Bethlehem

The dear Christ enters in.

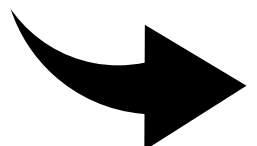
O holy Child of Bethlehem,
