The submitted D&A Heritage Statement does not address the development's impact on the setting of this heritage asset and, as the drawings are not annotated, it is not clear what materials are being used and where.
				Building works appear to have already commenced with the installation of replacement UPVC bay windows at ground floor level. The framing layout, having one large pane to the centre window and small vent lights either side, is not sympathetic to the surrounding architecture and the UPVC material being white in colour makes it that much more noticeable. 				Please also note 'Keepers of Time' a statement policy from England's Ancient and Native Woodland jointly written by Defra/The Forestry Commission. Considering the above points Looe Town Council believe that the proposed tree removal should be considered under the overall planning application for the proposed housing development as a reference is made within this application, it states ' Further New Building'. We therefore consider that this proposal is connected, and we highlight to you that the area is sensitive due to water runoff issues and land stability within a residential area.
