15 January 2025	PA25/00261 Josep Sandercock	River View, The Quay Looe	The addition of x3 rooflights and fibre cement roof tiles & hanging replaced with natural slate.
16 January 2025	PA25/00283 Josep Sandercock	1 Portbigam, The Quay West Looe	Listed Building Consent for refurbishment of Flat.
9 January 2025	PA25/00142 Josep Sandercock	Trehaven Manor Hotel Station Road East Looe	Works to a tree in a Conservation Area for Sycamore (T1) - remove to ground level. Tree has dead stem on Northeast side, declining stem on North side, included unions, and decay at base from previous pruning.
9 January 2025	PA25/00139 Josep Sandercock	Glendower Dawes Lane North View East Looe	Works to Tree(s) within a Conservation Area (TCA) - No's 1 & 2 Silver Firs - both dead, 50-55 feet tall. Danger of falling into Dawes Lane. Take down by section to ground level. No 3 Atlantic Pine 45 feet - dead and a danger to the house. Take down by section to ground.
