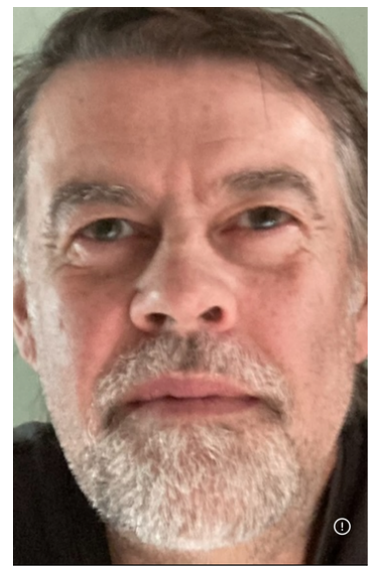

Introducing Looe Library's next Writer in Residence... Graeme Sandford



Graeme has written quite a few self-published paperback books, 'Wonky Words', 'Even Wonkier Words', 'Warm Yellow Custard Lake (and other short stories)', and 'The Hot Black Current Lagoon (and other short stories)' to name but four, and a number of e-books so far; he has also had a number of poems published in various publications, and even a short play based upon Terry Pratchett's Hat and Typewriter performed in Salisbury's Fringe Festival by professional actors; a couple of poems read out on BBC Radio Cornwall (one, personally); is a creator of the verse form 'the Badriomaku', and has received all sorts of mentions here, there, and somewhere else.

Graeme writes laterally, producing quirky words upon seagulls, the sea, Triffids, Binary, Butterflies, Shakespeare, and all Stations South West.

Graeme is a poet, wordsmith, writer, humourist, quirky and lateral thinker, husband to lovely Jane, with three dogs, and a cat - so he is also a dog-walker, and a cat-scratch post.
